### General rules

1. Entry Forms for animal exhibits are located in the back of this catalog or may be obtained from the University of Maryland Extension, Cecil County 4-H office.
  2. All animals entries must be postmarked by the deadline date listed on entry form. The entries must contain all fees required for class.
  3. Animals must be on the grounds by the date and time listed in the Rules and Regulations of the individual section.
  4. Animals staying may NOT be removed from the grounds until 11 p.m. Saturday, July 28, 2018. Premium money will be withheld from exhibitors not complying.
  5. NO ADMISSION PASSES WILL BE FURNISHED. Exhibitors will be permitted to enter during official entry times; however, anyone accompanying exhibitor will be required to pay appropriate admission charges.
  6. All 4-Hers will be required to handle their own 4-H animal projects.
  7. Clovers may not enter any 4-H animal classes.
  8. A maximum of 12 small animals per species may be shown per exhibitor in the 4-H and open divisions. (12 chickens, 12 waterfowl (ducks and geese), 12 rabbits, 12 cavies, 12 dogs, and 12 pets) Each meat rabbit trio and broiler and duck pair counts as one entry.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Open participation to anyone in or outside of Cecil County.
- No entry will be accepted unless presented in writing, upon the proper entry blank and signed by the exhibitor. NO PHONE ENTRIES. Proper entry fee must accompany form or you will not be able to show.
- Entry fee is \$.50 per open entry. 4-Hers can show open and 4-H.
- 4-H Rabbits on display will be housed in the Rabbit Building and must be in place by 4 p.m. on Saturday, July 21, 2018. Exhibitors coming day of show must arrive between 7 a.m. and 8 a.m.
- Guinea Pigs will be released to their exhibitors following the show. None will stay in barn for the week.
- Entry forms must be filled out completely, including breed, sex, tattoo number and age of animal. This is as given in the latest edition of the American Rabbit Breeders Association Standard of Perfection. This and rules may be obtained by writing to: American Rabbit Breeders Association, 1401 East Oakland Avenue, Bloomington, IL 61701.
- All animals must be the sole property of the exhibitor.
- All 4-H husbandry exhibitors must participate in barn duty. A schedule will be made when you enter.
- The greatest care will be taken for all animals, but the show will not be responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage from whatever arises. All animals shall be exhibited in their natural condition.
- No cards or inscriptions will be allowed on coops until after judging has been completed.
- All animals will be checked the day of the show. Any stock showing signs of disease will be removed from the show. Please stay with animals until check-in and in proper coops.
- Show official's word is final. Anyone disagreeing in abusive or unpleasant manner will have rabbits removed from show and premiums will be forfeited.
- No Does with litters or pregnant Does will be allowed in show.
- No animals under 3 months old.
- Exhibits can NOT be removed until 11 p.m. on Saturday, July 28, 2018. Release of rabbits due to extremely hot weather will be at the discretion of show Chairman with the approval of the Fair Board.
- All exhibitors must clean cage daily, provide own bedding, and dispose of refuse properly. This will be strictly enforced.
- Rabbits and Guinea pigs must be permanently earmarked in the left ear one week prior to show. If any questions, please contact Kelly Kalman. 4-Hers will not be charged for this service.
- No more than 4 entries per individual per class.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for bringing food and water containers that cannot flip and providing their own food.
- Meat rabbits must be under 70 days of age and weigh between 3 and 5 pounds each. (Born on or after May 14, 2018)
- As with any 4-H animal project, your rabbits are your responsibility. 4-H members are required to clean their cages daily. Un-kept cages will result in the removal of the rabbit(s) from the fairgrounds. If your animals are asked to be removed it may result in the loss of your premium money. Your rabbit projects are on display for the public; if you cannot make the commitment to care for your rabbits you need to make other arrangements.
- Exhibitors must complete a self certification of rabbit/cavy health form and present it to the animal health committee upon arrival/entry to the fairgrounds.
- Animals will not be broken down as to color, unless there are 10 or more per sex and color.
- The Cecil County Fair Board encourages all 4-H and open class participants to market themselves and their products, but animals and products entered into the competition at the Fair are NOT to be sold and leave the fair grounds during the Fair week. Animals which are not entered in Fair classes will not be permitted on the fairgrounds at any time, for the health and safety of all exhibitors' animals. Please contact your barn chairperson if you have questions.**
- Rabbit hopping exhibition will take place between showing.
