2. Flowers must have long stems, and displayed in a disposable glass container. No tiny containers
3. Leaves should be removed only on the portion of the stem that is under water.

Basis for judging - True to variety type, Uniform in size, shape, color, Mature, Free from injury and damage, fresh, healthy appearance

3. All extracted honey entries must be exhibited in 1 lb. glass or clear plastic jars.
4. All chunk and finely granulated honey entries must be exhibited in glass or clear plastic jars of 1lb. or more capacity.
5. All comb honey entries must be wrapped in clear cellophane or be placed in window cartons.
