

Classic And Farm Stock Rules

Friday, July 24th

Classic/Farm Stock Weigh in @ 3PM, Pull @ 6:30PM

1. Safety is number one priority, if we feel something is unsafe, we reserve the right to not let you pull.
2. All Entry Forms must be completed and signed. Any operators under the age of 18 will require the signature of a Guardian. Any operators demonstrating questionable driving skills will be challenged and track officials may refuse to hook.
3. 2 hook limit per tractor.
4. Flagman has control of the pull, if you are red flagged stop immediately or you will be DQ'd, no exceptions.
5. No cut tires, if we can see they are cut (Grinder marks, hot knife marks, planer marks, etc) you will be disqualified.
6. Hitch; Hole size to be 3" wide x 3-3/4" long MINIMUM. Hook point to be a minimum of 18" back from the centerline of the rear axle, and a maximum of 20" high. This will be checked at the scale. If we cannot fit the

hook in your hitch, you will not pull.

7. RPM's; Rpm's will be limited to a maximum of 3,000, if we feel you are in question, we do reserve the right to check you, denial to do so will result in DQ
8. Speed; Farm Stock/Classic will run at an 8.0 mph pace, 8.1 or higher will result in DQ. Enhanced Farm Stock will be 16.0 mph, 16.1 or higher will be a DQ. A speed board will be used.
9. Safety Equipment; ALL ENHANCED (16MPH) TRACTORS MUST HAVE THE FOLLOWING
 - a. Wheelie bars
 - b. Guillotine Air shutoff with sled and driver hookups
 - c. Helmets required for roll cage, highly recommended for roll bar
10. No weights may hang behind the rear tires, nor may they extend farther forward than 13' from the centerline of the rear axle. Wheel weights may not stick out past the axle. Weights may not obstruct the hookman from hooking/unhooking you from the sled,

if they cannot safely hook you, we reserve the right to not allow you to pull.

11. Tires to be a maximum of 24.5 width
12. Any decision made the day of the pull, supersedes these rules
13. No injectables of any kind
14. CLASSIC/Farm Tractor models in production 1960 to 1985,
